Bee



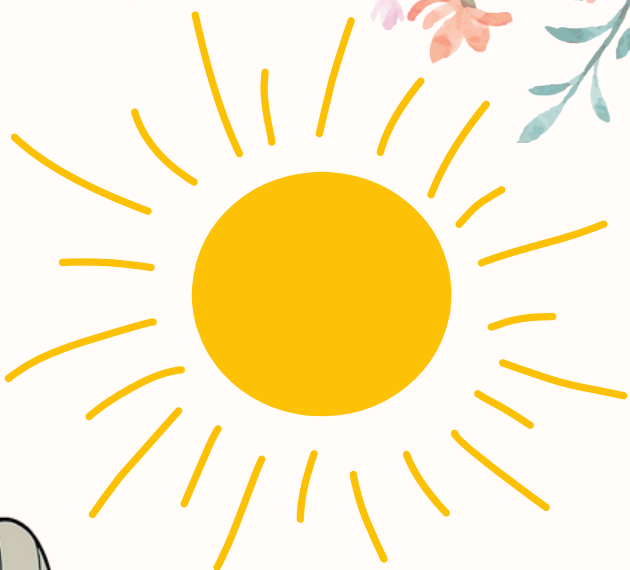
One sunny morning,

It was time to work.





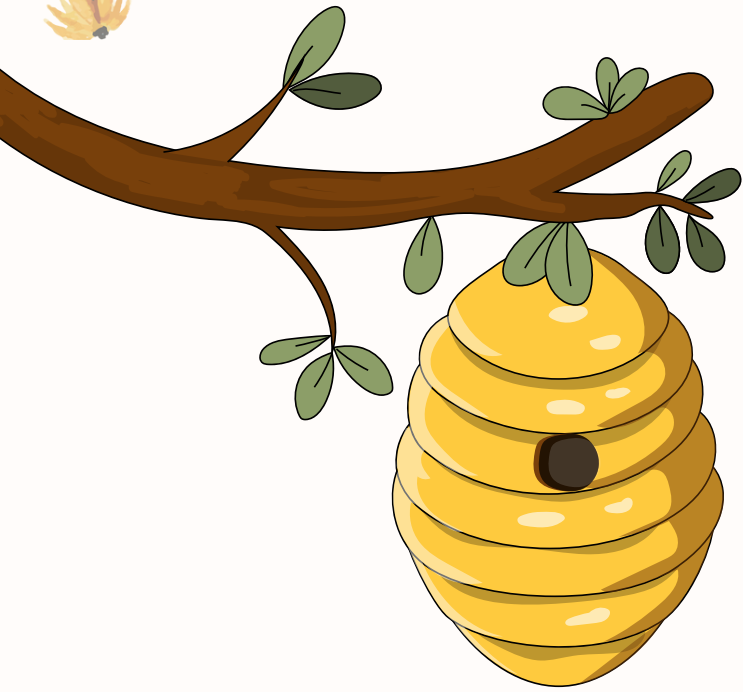


**Katerina** flew out of the hive.

It tasted sweet.





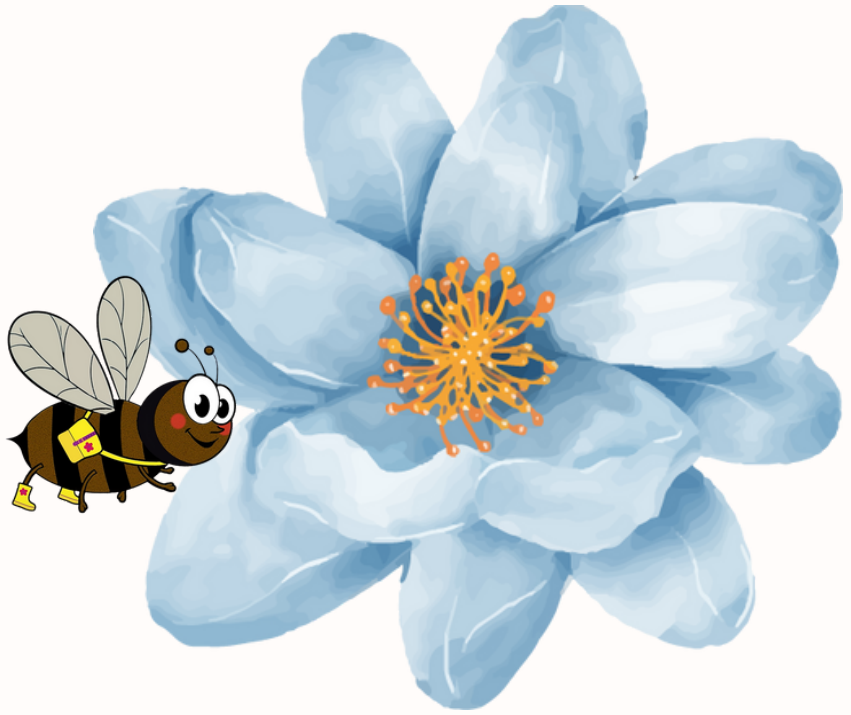


Next, **Katerina** found a blue

All the bees were coming back.





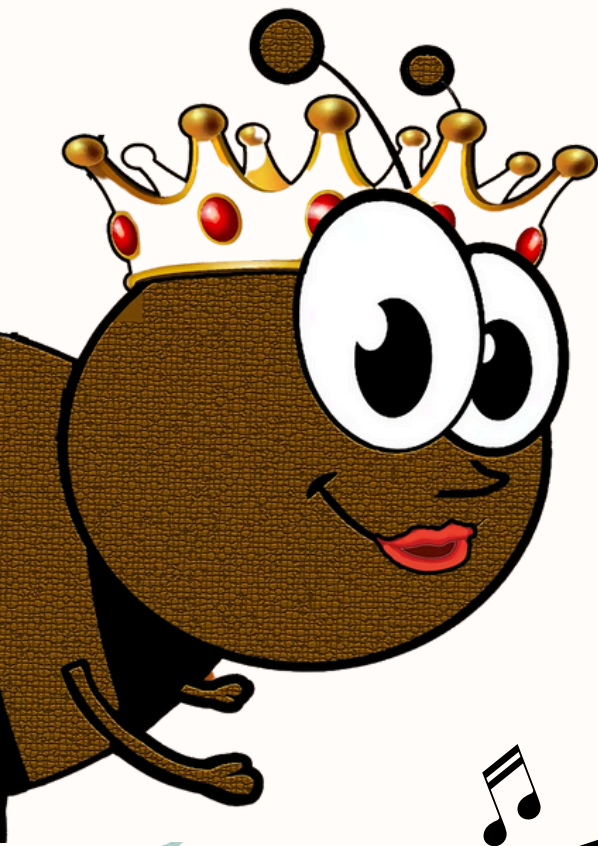


The queen bee waited in the

She hoped children would help.





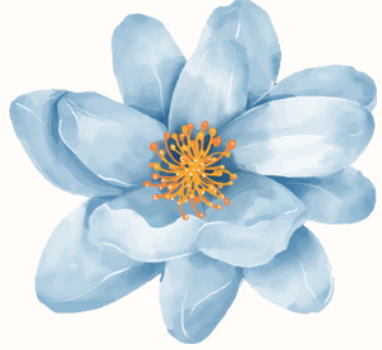
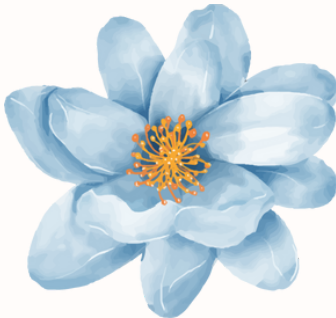


We can help bees by planting
